Product description

This is an app that suggests a menu for dinner. This app can also suggest a list of different courses such as appetisers, soups, entrees, or desserts. The app also help users filter the distance radius of the restaurants' location. This app provides solutions to almost everybody.

User needs


The "dinnow" app suggests dinner dishes through lists with images for users to choose what they might like to have. Users can save the suggestions, know where to get them to enjoy them.

This food delivery app is fast and convenient for ordering from restaurants.

Users view menus, categories and deals of restaurants that deliver in users' area.

Features included deals and vouchers; simple and safe payments; saving several addresses to order food faster.

App saves previous orders allowing users to reorder favorite meals.

After placing orders, users receive a text message with the order details and expected delivery time. Shake Shack app lets users choose and order items from their burger chain's menu.

Users can order ahead and customize orders on iPhones, skipping long lines.

The drawback is it takes time for users to be able to get their orders after placing them from the app.

However, the app is still a convenient tool for busy people to save some time by skipping waiting time in the lines for their lunches.

User can order sushi at home directly from iPhone, iPod, and iPad, in addition to be able to locate the nearest restaurants.

User can register different delivery addresses.

Users receive reports of the status of orders.

Enable saving features of users' favorite dishes.

The app haves a reviews and rating info. After ordering, users receive a short survey about the delivery time, and food quality. Users can also write a review.

The app accepts cash and PayPal payments.

App search lets users find the food dishes they crave.

App is available on mobile and tablet.

App haves order history feature.

For users who love to cook for themselves or family, but short on time and kitchen skills, this could be a perfect app.

App provides meal subscription service by shipping quick-preparing time, easy recipes, and exact amounts of ingredients needed to make home-cooked meals.

App has instruction clarity and options for days per week, seafood choices, desserts, and preferred/ special diets.

Summary

This gathering and summarizing data show what users need from the "dinnow" app:

Most people often having the problem of finding ideas for their dinners. They are potential users of the dinnow app.

Half of the people from the survey think they will use the app. We need to persuade them with very appealing and simple to use app, and very good advertising campaigns. Once they decided to use it, they are likely to use often.

The app needs many fast and simple suggestions and informations on local restaurants, delis and markets for their conveniences in short steps.

It should have a section for users to store their previous choices or favorite dishes.

User Scenario:





Changes to improve

Consider remove preparation style, perhaps also give healthy choice options.

Categorize dinner suggestions by Appetizer, Entree, Soup, ... etc.

Build dietary consideration into profile. Provide options for users to look for food/meals for someone else.

Be clear on choices for whether users are eating at home, picking up food, or eating out.

Need to provide option for transport time radius needed to travel.
